Paralana Joint Venture Project Update

Petratherm and its JV partners, Beach Petroleum and TRUenergy Geothermal advise that logging information has been collected with logging-while-drilling (LWD) tools to a depth of 3,740 metres. The logs are currently being evaluated.

Significant rain at site is expected to delay the forward operations.

The well will take a period of time to approach temperature equilibrium due to it having been drilled with mud cooled at the surface. It is planned that measurements be undertaken about four weeks after the well has been cased.

While those measurements should provide a more accurate assessment of the long term well temperature, experience with other similar wells has shown that the well temperature continues to increase and can take a few months to achieve its full equilibrium temperature.

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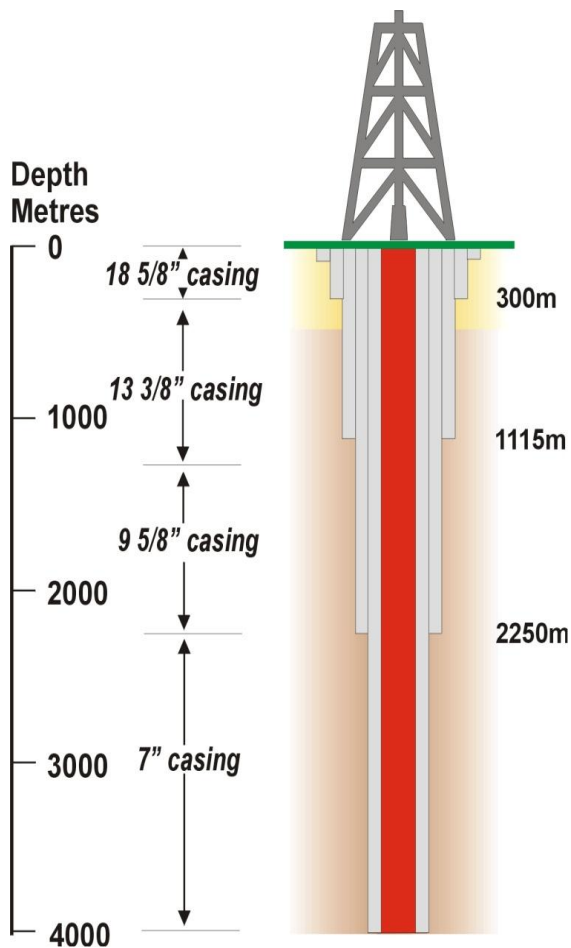
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Paralana 2 well achieved target depth of 4012 metres
